Dayton Bluffs Preserve - North Trail

Welcome to Dayton Bluffs Preserve! This exceptional 253-acre preserve is rich in local history, diverse habitats that include multiple ravines, unique geological features and several prehistoric archeological sites, and restored prairies along more than a mile along the banks of the Fox River.

Woodland Loop Trail and Ravine overlook


This short woodland loop trail gives hikers a beautiful view of two small ravines as they merge. These ravines reveal unique geologic features that include sedimentary rock layers of shale, limestone, coal, and sandstone dating from the Paleozoic Era, a mere 250 to 550 million years ago!

Be sure to stop and listen along the trail for the sounds of the woods. Can you identify any of the birdsongs you hear? Also watch for Red Tailed Hawks and Turkey Vultures soaring overhead as they hunt for food.

You may also see signs of woodpeckers at work on the trees...both Pileated and Red-headed Woodpeckers have made their home here.
